

Fish Toss Craft

Used with:

Story of the Fishin' Mission – Jesus calls disciples

Supplies needed:

1. 8oz. blue plastic cup
2. Power drill
3. String
4. Construction paper (bright colors)
5. Paper clip
6. Penny
7. Memory verse on labels
8. Snack-sized Ziploc baggies

Prepare ahead:

1. Drill 2 medium holes in end of plastic cup about ½" apart and off-center
2. Cut string into 22" lengths
3. Cut small, double fish (per pattern) from construction paper*
4. Put string, penny, fish, paper clip and memory verse in snack-sized Ziploc baggies

*Mardel's sells small wooden "fish" key rings that work great with this craft. They are about \$0.10/fish.

Children's activity:

1. Give each child a baggie and cup
2. Put ends of string through holes in end of cup and tie in knot
3. Fold fish over string, put penny in middle of fish, slide paper clip over fish/string/penny
4. Stick memory verse on cup
5. Swing and 'catch' the fish in the plastic cup
